Laugesen, b. 1942 is one of Denmark's most important living poets. Since his debut with "Landscape" in 1967 he has published some 70 collections of poems and received many prizes: The Grand Prize of the Danish Academy in 1992 is the most important. Since 1997 he is himself a member of The Danish Academy. In March his latest work, "Letter for a painter" will be in the bookstores. Laugesen is no stranger to the Greek audience. In 2015 he performed at the 2nd Athens World Poetry Festival. He is an experienced performer of his own poetry with music, mostly jazz, but on this occasion he will be accompanied by Greek musicians playing Greek music: Panayotis Petropoulos on violin and Charalambos Papanikolaou on lute.
