"Reconstruction" of life at Trelleborg Viking Fortress 980 AD.

Trelleborg Viking Fortress, built in AD 980 by King Harold Bluetooth, is one of the most remarkable monuments from the Viking Age, and it played a very important role in the formation of the first Danish state. With its monumental character and uniform geometric construction this monument reflects a highly developed technical expertise and organisational manifestation. The fortress, the long house and the reconstructed Viking Village provides the setting for the museum's re-enactment-based interpretation and presentation, hands-on activities and craft demonstrations. Authenticity is fundamental and all education and dissemination programmes are thus based on research. A new modern museum is planned to be realised over the next few years.
