We follow in polar-explorer Knud Rasmussen's footsteps. *Big Knud* grew up in Greenland with a Danish father and a part Inuit mother in the 1850's.

As a grown man, he returned to his true homeland to explore and to research the Inuit ways of life. He won the hearts of the Danes. But all his life he was hanging from this pendulum between the comfortable life in Denmark and the freedom of the cold North.

Pernille takes us with him into the cold, into the great white nothingness, the northern lights, and the meetings with the beautiful people, the Inuits, and their myths and songs.
